

Analysis Of Natural Tourism Of Anambas Island Riau Islands

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Abstract . The Anambas Islands are small islands in Indonesia, which are located in the South China Sea. The Anambas Islands are also part of the Riau Archipelago Province, which is surrounded by many small islands, most of which are uninhabited but still have pristine natural beauty. The aim of this research is to analyze community empowerment in community-based tourism development and develop a strategy for developing community-based tourism development to increase local revenue. The latest report from the Department of Tourism and Creative Economy of Riau Province highlights the importance of investment in hotel and port development.

ETIS THEORY STUDY

According to the results of the analysis (*Oksep Adhayanto, Kemudi; Journal of Government Science*) it is stated that the maritime-based tourism development policy is seen from the process of implementing the Tourism Strategic Plan policy. The implementation process is measured through the variables proposed by Van Mater and Van Horn. Variables in the implementation process that do not support each other and unclear standards and targets of the policy itself have resulted in a lack of availability or creation of tourism infrastructure, thereby hampering the growth and development of the maritime tourism industry in the Anambas Islands.

The Anambas Islands tourism development was developed based on the strength of natural marine tourism attractions with exotic, artificial, historical and cultural small islands only as support. From what we can see, this region has geostrategic value for Indonesia because it directly faces the South China Sea. The Anambas Islands are bordered by Vietnam's North Natuna Sea from the north, Bintan Regency from the south, Malaysia's Natuna Sea from the west, and Natuna Regency from the east.

According to research (*Wijaya, S.Hut., M.Si.*) it is predicted that the Anambas Islands have an area of 46,029.77 km, with details of 46,029.77 km. Other details say that 98.65% is ocean and 634.37 km or 1.35% is plain/land. This island is one of the islands with extensive waters in Indonesia and is even ranked among the largest and most beautiful islands in the world, and has very high natural tourism potential. There are also various other tourist attractions such as man-made, cultural customs and historical heritage. The details obtained are that there are approximately *150 objects, 74% natural tourism, 44 objects, 41% cultural tourism, then the remaining 4 objects, 2% man-made tourism* .

Tourism facilities in the Anambas Islands include: 19 accommodation units spread across 5 sub-districts, 47 restaurant units, 3 souvenir shops, 4 bank facilities/ATM machines. Access to the Anambas Islands can be via sea and air. The gates for these two routes can be accessed through Letung Harbor, Tarempa Harbor, Letung Airport and Anambas Airport. 4 large sea ports which can be entry points for domestic and foreign tourists, three in Siantan and one in Jemaja.

RESEARCH METHODS

This article uses qualitative methods, via the internet as the main means used to obtain a lot of information regarding the shortcomings, advantages, symptoms, facts, etc., regarding the island of Pulau Anambas. By using the kuliatis method which is centered on in-depth observation. So research can cover more aspects.
